Greetings Mr Ashe,

For advice to the Office of the Governor, Deputy Governor and Common Council of the Company of Merchant Adventurers, *Cygnis insignis*, along with the Office of the Lord High Admiral, the Office of the Lord Mayor of the Merchant City of Perth, and Foreign Diplomatic and Consular agents within our sovereign territory. For the interest of the Colonial Federation, the Union, the Empire and the interested General public, by Notice, Proclamation and Gazette.

Inquest: *The Mystery, Company, and Fellowship of Merchant Adventurers for the Discovery of Regions, Dominions, Islands, and Places Unknown (1551).*

Notice: Taking back Crown property – Maritime Claims for Breach of Charter Party.

1. Colonial Legislation and Statutes of the Realm remain in force in Western Australia and the Dependencies, Judiciary Act 1903 notwithstanding, Statute of Frauds 1677 (Western Australia).
1. *Force majeure* prevents performance (UNIDROIT 7.1.7), all contracts may be void and inoperative for want of law.
2. Diplomatic and Consular recognition may avoid property confiscation, arrest and/ or ejectment, the New Westralia trade moratorium may be available on exchange of guarantees.
 1. Note: Sovereign non-interference may not apply to government entity's, corporate entity's, or trading company's operating by (*De facto*) government agreements, convention or undertakings contrary to law, or by extra territorial application in the territories, ignorance of the law is no defence.
 2. Note: Residence in the colony may be subject to withdrawal, privileges may be suspended, maritime Liens may apply, Aliens Restriction (Amendment)Act 1919.

3. Be advised that the re-registration, re-assignment, transfer, garnishee or arrest of persons and property to the Government of New Westralia takes effect on delivery receipt as enclosed. All real and personal property, tangible and intangible, corporeal and incorporeal property, is here claimed for the Crown, search, seizure and arrest warrants may apply.
 1. For the safe entry and quiet enjoyment, private use, possession and ownership of property, and for the transfer of business to the Government of New Westralia as properly seized of the law, the honor is with the sovereign of New Westralia.
 2. Amend the record and ensure all officers and agents recognise and respect the Government of New Westralia, and ensure that the Government of New Westralia has right of way, safe harbor and safe carriage throughout the territories, G.P.U 1874.
 3. Anyone wishing to leave the colony must give notice and have the leave of the Court. Maritime liens may follow the absconder, Extradition Act 1870.
4. The Western Australia Commissioner of Police (WAPOL ABN: 91 724 684 688) may be joined as a (violating) party (*In personam*), criminally negligent (malice aforethought) for all unsafe statutory demands, infringement, trespass or tort against colonial subjects (Non citizen, non alien), the Crown or appointed agents of the government of New Westralia, Police Act 1892.
 1. Note: The *violating party* shall be liable for damages or remedies as provided by law, *Lex situ*, *Lex fori*, *Lex loci*, Colonial Courts of Admiralty Act 1890.
 2. Officers must show a proper warrant of authority on demand considering the Commissioner attempts to diminish the rights of colonial subjects by non recognition, obstruction or administrative malfeasance, as it appears to prejudice a foreign power, Uniform Law Application Act 2022.
 3. The arrest of a suspect (or charged suspect) must be made by written court order addressing the legal entity identifier of the intended target, person or corporation.
 4. Criminal Investigation (Identifying People) Act 2002 must not violate civil rights, individual rights or political liberty, coercion may be an offence against the law. WIPO may be subject to audit and investigation.



5. The Governor, Deputy Governor and Common Council as principal party (*The Company*) for the Department of Transport taking these letters has surety for acceptance of this (our) offer, with receipt of this (enclosed) payment acceptance required as a matter of general mercantile law.
6. The Government of New Westralia (Bank of New Westralia) herein issues notice of proper payment as presented for honor, as the interim arrangement and currency to restore colonial governance by the New Westralia Transitional Authority.

The *De facto* government retains as far as possible in the circumstances, limited responsibility as acting civil administrator to control and discipline their agents, employees, or contractors while operating under temporary orders by dormant commission only for the handing over Crown property under the Transitional Authority of New Westralia.
 1. Note: False or misleading advice may be an offence.
 2. Note: Misconduct may include default.
 3. Note: Hague IV 1907 may be enforceable for offences against the Crown and foreign agents (or contractors) operating without proper authority in the colonial territories.

 1. As offered without prejudice, non assumpsit, in good faith, without ill-will, vexation or frivolity, Constitution Act 1889. Colonial legislation has the force of law in the colonies, with prejudice.

With the unconditional surrender of property as a conditon of service made good and all keys, passes, codes, accounts, ledgers, books, records and every useful thing or things to be delivered complete, intact and accounted for.

Privileges, benefits accrued and some property may be retained, subject to good behaviour and early adoption to the Transitional Authority of New Westralia.

Those who may wish to quit the colony may negotiate on their own surety for safe passage and exchange of personnel where possible and appropriate. A relocation package may be available for those seeking new employment.

Where we have not received a positive response, or receipt for payment, or letters of negotiation we must assume the Company of Merchant Adventurers, *Cyginis insignis* intends or admits itself as openly hostile to the Crown, in conspiracy to defraud the Crown, in disregard of the law and made good for arrest without further notice. The Grant of Settlement collapses on default or by misconduct or mischief injuring this investigation or the person of the colonial Commissioner, *Custos rotalurum*.

The Colonial Commissioner, *Custos rotulurum* here takes charge of government on dormant commission by devolution of law, Notice, Proclamation and Gazette.

June 5, 1933 [H.J.Res. 192]

To assure uniform value to the coins and currencies of the United States,

Whereas the holding of or dealing in gold affect public interest, and are therefore subject to proper regulation and restriction; and

Whereas the existing emergency has disclosed that provisions of obligations which purport to give the obligee a right to require payment in gold or a particular kind of coin or currency of the United States, or in an amount in money of the United States measured thereby, obstruct the power of the Congress to regulate the value of the money of the United States, and are inconsistent with the declared policy of the Congress to maintain at all times the equal power of every dollar, coined or issued by the United States, in the markets and in the payment of debts, Now, therefore, be it Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, that

(a) every provision contained in or made with respect to any obligation which purports to give the obligee a right to require payments in gold or a particular kind of coin or currency, or in an amount in money of the United States measured thereby, is declared to be against public policy; and no such provision shall be contained in or made with respect to any obligation hereafter incurred. Every obligation, heretofore or hereafter incurred, whether or not any such provision is contained therein or made with respect thereto, shall be discharged upon payment, dollar for dollar, in any coin or currency which at time of payment is legal tender for public and private debts. Any such provision contained in any law authorizing obligations to be issued by or under authority of the United States, is hereby repealed, but the repeal of any such provision shall not invalidate any other provision or authority contained in such law.

(b) As used in this resolution, the term 'obligation' means any obligation (including every obligation of and to the United States, excepting currency) payable in money of the United States; and the term 'coin or currency' means coin or currency of the United States, including Federal Reserve notes and circulating notes of Federal Reserve banks and national banking associations.

Sec. 2 The last sentence of paragraph (1) of subsection (b) of section 43 of the Act entitled 'An Act to relieve the existing national economic emergency by increasing agricultural purchasing power, to raise revenue for extraordinary expenses incurred by reason of such emergency, to provide emergency relief with respect to agricultural indebtedness, to provide for the orderly liquidation of joint-stock land banks, and of other purposes;', approved May 12, 1933, is amended to read as follows:

"All coins and currencies of the United States (including Federal Reserve notes and circulating notes of the Federal Reserve banks and national banking associations) heretofore or hereafter coined or issued, shall be legal tender for all debts, public and private, public charges, taxes, duties, and dues, except that gold coins, when below the standard weight and limit of tolerance provided by law for the single piece, shall be legal tender only at valuation in proportion to their actual weight."

§ 3-603. TENDER OF PAYMENT.

(a) If tender of payment of an obligation to pay an instrument is made to a person entitled to enforce the instrument, the effect of tender is governed by principles of law applicable to tender of payment under a simple contract.

(b) If tender of payment of an obligation to pay an instrument is made to a person entitled to enforce the instrument and the tender is refused, there is discharge, to the extent of the amount of the tender, of the obligation of an indorser or accommodation party having a right of recourse with respect to the obligation to which the tender relates.

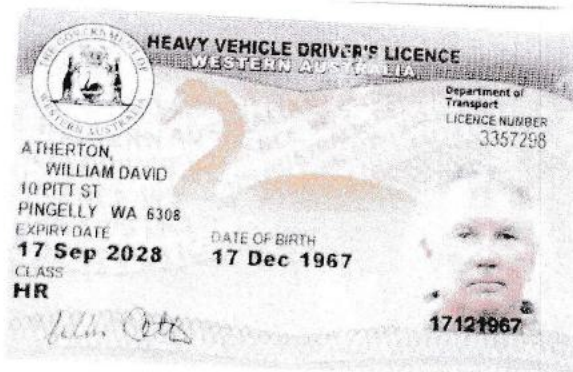
