Specific instructions.

1. Secure the Port, and ALL Crown property and personnel.
2. I hereby instruct the Harbor Master to issue a General Shipping Notice to all incoming vessels informing the Owner, Shipping Agent and Master that the removal of ANY and ALL Crown property may be subject to Ship Arrest, Detention, Confiscation, Lien, Recovery, or other effects of the unlawful taking of private Crown property.
 1. No entry of Any Port in Western Australia is permitted by foreign registered vessels designated for loading, removal or the export out of the State of Crown property until further notice, subject to arrest and detention.
 2. These instructions do not affect Imports, emergency docking, resupply/ bunkering or general mail delivery.



3. The Harbor Master is to ensure all documentation and communications for import arrivals, intended export arrivals/ diverted export arrivals, bunkering, or emergency docking, and all matters relating to the regular duties of the Harbor Master, Pilot and Port Security, and matters relating to Schedule 7 Port Authorities Act 1999, are accurately maintained and forwarded to the above address weekly.
 1. Any suspicious activity, seizing, destroying or doctoring of historical documentation, records or cargo manifests or attempts to over ride this authority, pressure, coerce, threaten or impose penalty, fine or charge against Port staff, unlawful Port movements, unlawful loading, or attempts to remove Crown property on site, in bulk handling facilities, sampling facilities, etc may be reported to the above address for our immediate intervention.
 2. Designated Inspectors may be dispatched to secure the Port operations and Crown property where it is deemed nessasary, any interference, obstruction or delay in their official function may be an offense against the Crown.
 3. You will be issued notice of our designated Official or Investigator prior to their arrival and requested to assist their inspection of the Port.
 4. Due to the extraordinary nature of these matters, and predictable uncertainty surrounding these things you may be issued contradictory advice or orders attempting to override this authority, disregard this notice at your peril.
 5. Courts- Martial Jurisdiction is now in effect.

 1. All attempts to contact Mr Quinlan and other representatives purporting to be official officers of the Crown have been ignored leading to Emergency Powers - A State of Emergency Declaration being enacted, Defense of the Realm Consolidation Act 1914.
