[Extract] Draft of a Bill.

To provide, for a limited time, for the Government of His Majesty's Settlements in Western Australia, on the Western Coast of New Holland (3 April, 1829).

*"And whereas it is necessary to make some temporary provision for the Civil Government of the said Settlement until the said Undertaking shall be further matured, and the number of Colonists in the said Settlements increased"*

**Temporary Orders.**

1. Standing Orders Legislative Council, Section 3, Temporary Orders Suspended.
2. Standing Orders Legislative Assembly, Section 3, Temporary Orders Suspended.



**Important Note:** Extra territorial jurisdiction of Australia/ the Commonwealth is removed, the operation of laws rests with **Constitution Act 1899** (Imp) for interim accommodation, continuance of trade, and to maintain the peace and security of the state, without prejudice, non assumpsit, *Lex fori*, *lex loci*.

The Royal Commission of Inquiry is in session:

- *Placita Coronae, Capitula Itineris.*
- *Modus Tenendi Parliamentum.*
- *Placita De Quo Warranto, (EDW I, II & III).*
- *Placita De Ragemannis, Rotuli De Ragemannis.*

The Governor and Lieutenant Governor to table their proper licensing and appointment papers, without delay, *Placita de quo warranto*.

All Ministers, Commissioners, Clergy, Naval and Army and Air Forces personnel, Judges, Masters, Justices, Registrars, Clerks, Directors, Officers, Agents and Assigns are to be inspected for proper licensing and appointment prior to any authorisation, expenditure, Bill, Treaty, order or recommendation, *Placita de quo warranto*.

Manifestly unlawful orders.

Every enrolled member of the general public, or administrative agent of the Crown may request papers of authority, or refuse **manifestly unlawful orders** or directions that may endanger the safety the state, without risk of insubordination, defamation, coercion, discipline or penalty being incurred, while in a state of emergency, or in occupation lawfully or unlawfully.

The Defence of Superior Orders.

General observations on the efficacy of systems of law, including International Law.

*The efficacy of every system of law depends on there being (i) a properly constituted authority competent to enact rules, (ii) a readiness on the part of inferior authorities to obey the rules enacted by superior authorities, and (iii) an adequate system of surveillance and enforcement to ensure that inferiors obey the rules enacted by their superiors.*

(Hague IV 1907)

ICRC Rule 154, Obedience to Superior Orders, *Every combatant has a duty to disobey a manifestly unlawful order.*

- Defence of the Realm Consolidation Act 1914.
- Hague IV 1907 (Lieber Code) - Command responsibility, (Yamashita Standard/ Medina Standard) to prevent criminal felony misconduct.



Proof of a properly constituted authority required.

All Agents of the Crown, including Civil and Ecclesiastical authorities must produce their proper licensing and appointment papers upon request or demand. Failure to provide evidence of proper appointment may be an offence against the Crown, Treason Felony Act 1848.

All Ministers of the Crown must table proper licensing and appointment documents in Parliament for the confidence of the general public without delay. Ministers unwilling or unable to table proper licensing and appointment papers may stand down or be suspended without further notice, Parliamentary Privileges Act 1891, Naval Discipline Act 1860.

Parliamentary Services and the Parliamentary Guard must produce proper licensing and appointment papers without delay. Unauthorised agents, contractors, or alien personnel occupying positions of security or Parliamentary authority must immediately stand down or be removed.

An inspection of the Guard will be carried out by the Commissioner in charge of government at a suitable and convenient time to ensure the Guard be properly prepared to inspect their honour, discipline, and preparedness to defend the Crown, and when it is deemed safe to do so.

The paramount force of law (Imperial), rests with the Commissioner in charge of the government, in right of the State, in right of the Crown, and in defence of the Realm.
